Noise

We want all of our guests to enjoy their stay at Strawberry Hill Farm, and we request that Campers are considerate and respectful to others, quiet time is between 10pm and 7.30am. If any noise crated can be heard on the pitch next to you, then it is too loud. Noisy behaviour is not acceptable and you will be asked to keep noise down. Failure to do so, may result in you being asked to leave, and no refund will be given. We thank you for your cooperation.

Barbecues

Barbecues are allowed and must be at least six inches off the ground. Blocks for disposable BBQ's can be provided, and we can also provide standing BBQ's, disposable BBQ's are for sale in Strawberry Hill Farm Reception. No other type of fire is permitted.

Children

Children must be supervised at all times

Dogs

Dogs are welcomed on Strawberry Hill Farm, and we ask that dogs are to be kept on a lead at all times and not left unattended in your unit.

Commercial Vehicles

We do not allow commercial vehicles on Strawberry Hill Farm.

Cycling

A standard maximum speed for all vehicles of 5mph. Cyclists must also use the road network only and not the grass

Visitors/Non residents

We are happy to consider any reasonable request for visitors, please just let us know if you are having visitors, as small charges may be incurred.

Departure/Early Departure

We politely ask that you leave Strawberry Hill Farm by 11am on your day of departure. If you decide to leave before your original leaving date we ask you to please let us know, and unfortunately no refunds are given.

Rubbish Disposal

Please note that the only waste product to be deposited in the dustbin area is domestic and kitchen waste. Any other waste is to be taken home and disposed of in the appropriate manner, this includes household and camping products.

Toilet/Shower Facilities

You are respectfully asked to leave the facilities as you would expect to find them. Facilities are serviced daily between 1.30pm and 2.30pm. Also during busy periods there is a potential that the Hot Water may run cool. If this happens we apologise, and the water will reheat in approximately 30/40 minutes.

TESCO - Directions/Facilities

Pass the Three Horseshoes Pub, (on the left), to the roundabout, and go straight across. Just after the Railway Bridge, turn right at the T junction road. Tesco is on the left. Tesco is open 24 hours and also has ATM/Cash machines and a Petrol Station. (3.2 miles away from Strawberry Hill Farm).

Park & Ride - Belmont - Directions/Facilities

Pass the Three Horseshoes Pub, to the roundabout. Turn right towards Sherburn. At Sherburn go straight across the mini roundabout to the next staggered cross road. The Blacksmiths Arms/restaurant is on your right. Go straight across to the dual carriageway A690, and turn left. Park and Ride is approximately 1 mile on the right.
